

DIRECT LARYNGOSCOPY/ESOPHAGOSCOPY/BRONCHOSCOPY DISCHARGE INSTRUCTIONS

FOLLOW UP CARE

- Talk in your normal voice, do not yell or whisper for 2 weeks
- Throat and ear pain are normal and should resolve in 2 weeks
- Tongue pain, numbness, or tingling are normal and should resolve in 2 weeks
- If a follow up appointment was not made the day of surgery, please call the office to make one

OPERATIVE SITE

- If biopsies were taken, you may notice a small amount of blood in your saliva

ACTIVITY

- Do not drive for 24 hours
- Avoid vigorous activity or heavy lifting for 2 weeks

DIET

- Begin with clear liquids and resume previous diet as tolerated

MEDICATIONS

- Prescription (s) will be sent with you. Use as directed.
- See PAIN CONTROL sheet for additional instructions.

PROBLEMS TO WATCH FOR

- Fever over 101.4
- Heavy bleeding
- Difficulty breathing
- Nausea/Vomiting
- Bleeding lasting more than 2 days
- Neck swelling
